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# UNDERLAYMENT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### **APPROVED SUBSTRATES**

- Dry, completely cured concrete (at least 14 days old with HVAC operating)
- ¾" interior plywood, OSB flooring, gypcrete (must be primed before glue down)
- Waterproofing and crack-isolation membranes
- Cement backer units
- Existing vinyl, wood, and laminate floors

### **FLOOR PREPARATION**

- Subfloor should be clean, dry and level.
- In areas where concrete subfloors are subject to excessive moisture, a calcium chloride moisture test is required. Vapor emission readings in excess of 7lbs per 1,000 square feet in 24 hours will require additional measures to be taken before installing underlayment.
- Follow the manufacturer's installation instructions for any additional preparation.

## **MIILLIKEN UNDERLAYMENT INSTALLATION**

Install Milliken Underlayment according to instructions as follows (also on Underlayment package label):

- Underlayment must first be bonded to the subfloor with FULL
  COVERAGE of Milliken LVT Standard adhesive or Milliken Mosaic
  98-Spray adhesive. This prevents any movement on the floor.
  "Double-stick" glue down procedure is required.
- First, plan the layout of the installation space. The underlayment should be applied to floor with the long direction perpendicular to the long direction of the LVT.
- Underlayment is easily cut with a knife or scissors.
- Roll out underlayment next to wall. Roll out next row in same manner, butting underlayment close to first row (do not overlap). One to two inches extra can be left at wall that is easily trimmed with razor knife after underlayment is glued to floor.
- Install Milliken Underlayment with <u>film UP, polyurethane down.</u>

#### Double glue installation instructions for Milliken LVT Standard adhesive:

- Spread adhesive with a 1/16" x 1/16" x 1/32" U-notch trowel in an area that can be installed within the working time of the adhesive. Allow adhesive to dry to the touch, creating a tacky adhesive surface.
- 2. Roll out underlayment, starting next to wall if possible. Roll with a 75-100 lb roller to smooth out any air pockets and to secure a good bond to the adhesive.
- Continue with next row of underlayment, rolling out in the same manner, butting underlayment close to the first row (do not overlap). Roll with a 75-100lb roller. Continue until desired space is covered.
- 4. Next, apply an underlayment seam tape to the seam, sealing the underlayment.
- Continue with installation of the LVT to the top side of the underlayment using adhesive as instructed in the Milliken LVT Installation Guide.

### Double glue installation instructions for Milliken Mosaic 98-Spray adhesive:

- Shake can well before use. Point can downward and press the side of the nozzle tip as you slowly walk back and forth to achieve full floor coverage of the adhesive. The coverage should be about 100-125 sq. ft. per can. Allow adhesive to dry to the touch, creating a tacky adhesive surface.
- 2. Roll out underlayment, starting next to wall if possible. Roll with a 75-100 lb roller to smooth out any air pocket and to secure a good bond to the adhesive.
- 3. Continue with the next roll of underlayment, rolling out in the same manner, butting the underlayment close to the first row (do not overlap). Again, roll with a 75-100 lb roller to smooth out any air pockets and to secure a good bond to the adhesive. Continue until the desired space is covered.
- 4. Next, apply an underlayment seam tape to the seam, sealing the underlayment.
- Continue with installation of the LVT on the top side of the underlayment using adhesive as instructed in the Milliken LVT Installation Guide.
